The UCSD International Center will present a forum on International Perspectives on Ethnicity at noon Feb. 4 at the International Center Lounge.

The goal of the event, according to Tec Kidane-Mariam, International Center foreign student advisor, is to understand how ethnicity is viewed by domestic and international students and to bring these two student groups together for dialogue and discussion.

Sandhya Shukla, UCSD Department of Ethnic Studies, will moderate the discussion. The panel will consist of Charles Briggs, also of Ethnic Studies; an international student, a U.S. student who has studied abroad, and a visiting research scholar.
