Subject: PAIELA LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCIL

During my Patrol No. 1 of 73/74 to the PAIELA Census Division I discussed the establishment of a L.G.C. within the PAIELA area, with people of all 11 villages. The following resulted:-

1. All people of all villages were in favour of coming within the Local Government system.
2. With the exception of 2 or 3 individuals the Paiela people are in favour of initially amalgamating with the Forgera L.G.C. L.G.C.
3. The PAIELA people would like it recorded that they would eventually prefer to have their own Council, but only after such a period of time had elapsed, when they were sufficiently an fait with the system and were sufficiently organized within their area to run their own L.G.C.
4. Meetings: Some ideas suggested by PAIELA Leaders were:-
 - i) Forgera L.G.C. executive staff, President, Clerk and Advisers to visit PAIELA each month to organize and assist in meetings at KOROMBI.
 - ii) Alternative monthly venues for Council meetings, viz, Forgera and Korombi. Councillors to fly at Government/Council expense. (MAF would fly the members at \$5 per person).
 - iii) Paiela people to hold their own normal monthly meetings at KOROMBI. When there were matters of major importance to be discussed only then would the Paiela Councillors all arrange to attend the meeting at Forgera.
 - iv) Each rest house group (11 in all) with the exception of PIANE-BEALO expressed the desire to have their own Councillor. PIANE-BEALO stated they would like to join with POLOTIKA and have the one Councillor for the three rest houses. This is currently the case with PURUK YOKE as the Polotika councillor. He has much influence in these two villages. Another Councillor may not be so readily accepted. It is unlikely that PURUK (currently Council President) will be deposed.

This report is self-explanatory but contains no useful recommendations as to the structure of the eight new records.

At its general meeting on the 28th February 1975, the Congress Council agreed with the amalgamation of the Palele people. As such the District Local Government Officer will be proceeding to Pongera on the 8th April to draft the necessary proclamation amendments for approval at the Council's meeting on the 30th April 1975.

With \$4000 R.I.P. funds this year the Council has arranged to build two teachers houses at Palele. Next year the Council has requested \$5000 R.I.P. (district priority 20) to commence building a road into the Palele area.



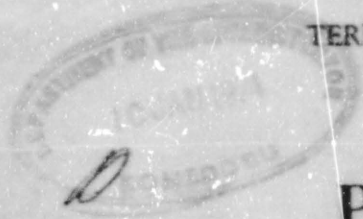
