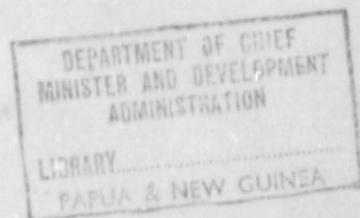



PATROL INSTRUCTIONS

BUT-BOIKEN CENSUS DIVISION PATROL

As verbally arranged, please prepare to depart on a routine patrol of the above Census Division. During the patrol, the census is to be revised, the area study revised and routine matters attended. Political Education discussions are to be held, with emphasis given to explaining the political and constitutional changes now taking place. The aims and methods of the Constitutional Planning Committee should be brought into discussions.


On completion of the patrol, situation reports from yourself are required on the following topics:-

1. Political Education; a brief resume of matters discussed and local attitudes expressed.
2. Peli Association; recent developments, particularly the response to the gaoling of Daniel HAWINA and others.
3. Food supply; an assessment of the effects of the current prolonged dry spell in relation to local food supply. It is likely that all villages have adequate sago reserves to supplement fewer root crop yields, but each village must be assessed to ensure that potential trouble spots are not appreciated.

At your discretion, Situation Reports may also be submitted on any other item of interest to Headquarters which may be noted by the patrol.

Mr. R. Ford is to accompany you and you should ensure that he is well acquainted with all aspects of routine patrolling. He is to compile the revision of the Area Study for the Census Division.

The Patrol Report is required within one week of the completion of the Patrol.
