In response to SAAC's request and the recommendations of Directors Aguilar and Adame, I hereby approve SAAC's request of change of status from being an "administrative committee" of the Vice Chancellor of Student Affairs to an "autonomous body". I have asked that this transition be implemented immediately and that the relevant campus publications and documents be revised accordingly. In light of this change, I have also asked that the Director of SAA/HR serve as resource for SAAC and that SAAC's relationship with SAA/HR be developed through discussions between SAAC and Director Adame.
