

## UC Education Abroad Program to offer students study year in South Africa for the first time

A year of study in South Africa for students at the University of California, San Diego and other University of California campuses is being offered for the first time by the UC system's Education Abroad Program (EAP).

The pilot program will be at the University of Natal, Pietermaritzburg campus, South Africa. Pietermaritzburg is the center of the Natal Midlands, close to nature reserves and parks and one hour's drive from the coastal city and major South African port of Durban.

The full year program will include courses in Zulu language and culture, wildlife science, rural sociology, zoology, resources management, political science, and colonial and South African literature. The academic year will run from mid-February to November, 1997.
