

Danish Gym Team to appear

November 7, 1968

The Danish Gym Team, organized and directed by Erik Flensted-Jensen, will appear at 8:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 14, in the University of California, San Diego, Gymnasium.

The program will include fundamental gymnastics, performances on balance beams, jazz gymnastics, vaulting and tumbling, compositions with tambourines, balls and ropes and Danish folk dances. The folk dances will be performed in colorful native costumes and to old Danish folk tunes.

The performing boys and girls were selected from the most skillful gymnasts in Denmark. Most of them are in their early twenties. Some of them are students, and the others represent a number of different careers. They have all taken a year off without salary of any kind. Their common interest is their dedication to physical education.

The series of gymnastics presented in the program have been made up by the instructors. The majority of the program is accompanied by music, mainly composed by the two pianists of the team.

During their tour of 1967-68, the Danish Gym Team gave 14 performances in Mexico, and it was at that time that the Mexican Olympic Organization Committee requested that they return and perform in Mexico City in connection with the Olympic Games.
