UCSD VISITORS PROGRAM OFFERS SUNSET WALKING TOURS OF CAMPUS

Free "sunset tours" of the University of California, San Diego campus will be offered to area visitors and residents every Wednesday this summer, from 6 to 7:30 p.m., starting June 22 and ending Aug. 31.

The tours, led by members of the UCSD Visitors Program, will originate from the south Gilman Information Pavilion.

Meanwhile, the two ongoing Sunday tours of the campus will continue, with mini-van tours available the first and third Sunday of each month and walking tours offered the second, fourth and fifth Sunday of the month. Each of these tours is held from 3 to 4:30 p.m. and originates from the Gilman Information Pavilion.

The free mini-van tours provide an overview of the entire UCSD campus in La Jolla, including Thornton Hospital and Scripps Institution of Oceanography. The walking tours include some of the internationally famed Stuart Collection of outdoor sculptures.

There is a minimal UCSD parking fee.
