SUBJECT: Status Report – UCSD Lactation Facilities and Services Pilot Program



The committee will continue to serve in an advisory capacity to the Vice Chancellors for Business Affairs and Resource Management and Planning, with a focus on the following activities:


- Monitor and evaluate the use of designated lactation space;
