

Yen-lu Wong served as delegate to First International Choreographers Conference held in New York

Yen-lu Wong, choreographer and assistant professor of drama at the University of California, San Diego served as a delegate to the First International Choreographers' Conference held in New York last month.

Ms. Wong joined such well known dancers and choreographers as Alvin Ailey, George Balanchine and Robert Joffrey as American delegates to the gathering sponsored by the Conseil International de la Danse in Paris, UNESCO, and the International Dance Council.

The conference was held November 12-15 at the United Nations and the Library and Museum of the Performing Arts at Lincoln Center.

Ms. Wong was the only West Coast dancer named as a delegate to the conference. She joined the UC San Diego faculty in 1974 and has served as an assistant professor, a resident artist and a teacher at a number of universities and theatre playhouses both in the United States and overseas.
