

Friends of the UCSD Library to hold book sale

The Friends of the UCSD Library will hold its fifth annual book sale from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday, May 7, and from 2 to 5 p.m. Sunday, May 8, on the entrance walk of the Central University Library at the University of California, San Diego.

The sale is open to the general public. Books for the sale, which benefits the UC San Diego libraries, come from a variety of sources, according to Alvina A. Robertson of the library's administrative staff. Many are donated by members of the community or members of the Friends to the libraries specifically for the sale. Many of the items to be sold were parts of large donations that contained books already owned by the libraries.

Of particular note among the offerings for this year's sale is a group of several hundred scholarly books on Romance languages. Almost every topic imaginable and every type of book, both scholarly and of general interest, will be represented among the weekend bargains.

In a departure from previous book sale procedure, any books not sold by the end of Saturday's all-day sale will be cut to half-price for the shorter Sunday sale.

Mrs. Geraldine McGilvery of La Jolla is chairwoman for the sale.
