FIVE FACULTY RECEIVE GUGGENHEIMS

Five faculty members at the University of California, San Diego have been named recipients of Guggenheim Awards for 1987.

The UCSD winners are: Jeffrey Brent Graham, research marine physiologist and senior adjunct lecturer at Scripps Institution of Oceanography; Clive W.J. Granger, professor of economics; Hyam Lerner Leffert, associate professor of medicine; Richard A. Olshen, professor of mathematics and director of the Laboratory for Mathematics and Statistics, and Faith Ringgold, professor of art.

The five are among 273 artists, scholars and scientists selected this year by the John Simon Guggenheim Memorial Foundation to share fellowship awards totaling \$6,336,000.

Guggenheim Fellows are chosen on the basis of unusually distinguished achievement in the past and exceptional promise for the future.
