

Cancellation of first Mandeville lecture

Dr. Milton Friedman, scheduled to give the opening Mandeville Lecture at the University of California, San Diego, Thursday, November 30, has been taken ill and has cancelled all speaking engagements for the next several months.

The 1972-73 series of lectures will now open with The Honorable Harold Wilson, former Prime Minister of Great Britain, at 8:00 p.m., Tuesday, January 9, in the Casa del Prado in Balboa Park. Wilson will be followed by Washington columnist Jack Anderson on Friday, January 12, and Sir Bernard Lovell, Director of Great Britain's Jodrell Bank Observatory on Thursday, February 15.

All lectures are free and open to the public.
