

Heilman to speak in Faculty Lecture Series in La Jolla on March 8

One of the nation's outstanding scholars in the field of English literature will present a free public lecture in La Jolla on Thursday, March 8.

He is Robert B. Heilman, Chairman of the Department of English at the University of Washington, Seattle, and author of such books as "This Great Stage: Image and Structure in King Lear," and "Magic in the Web: Action and Language in Othello."

In his La Jolla speech, Dr. Heilman will discuss "Thomas Hardy's Mayor of Casterbridge and the Problem of Intention."

The talk is one of the Faculty Lectures co-sponsored by the University of California, San Diego, and the Theatre and Arts Foundation of San Diego County. It will be given at Sherwood Hall, Art Center in La Jolla, Thursday, March 8, 8:00 p.m. The public is invited. Admission is free.
