UCSD WILL HOST ANNUAL PREVIEW DAY OCTOBER 5

The intricacies of becoming a student at the University of California, San Diego, in the 1992 fall quarter will be covered at a once-a-year "Preview Day" to be held Oct. 5 on the campus.

The event precedes the Nov. 1-30, 1991, filing period for UC applications and is planned to provide prospective students with a firsthand look at the university, its people and programs.

Students and their families will have an opportunity to discuss their interests with UCSD students, faculty and staff at either morning or afternoon sessions. Included are presentations on admissions, financial aid and housing; a student panel discussion; campus tours, and an information fair featuring UCSD's academic departments, campus life programs and student organizations. Additionally, two special sessions for transfer students from California community colleges will be available.

Two complete programs are offered, the first at 9:30 a.m. and the second at 12:30 p.m. Both programs are identical, so visitors can select the session that best suits their schedules.
