The Department of Economics at the University of California, San Diego will hold an annual conference sponsored by the National Science Foundation and the National Bureau of Economic Research on October 19 and 20 on time series analysis.

The conference will bring together some of the most prominent economists in the country who specialize in economic time series analysis and econometrics. Economic time series analysis is a field of study that involves looking at past economic activity to help model and forecast future trends.

The two-day conference will provide a forum for economic researchers and specialists representing leading universities and research institutions around the world to exchange new ideas and report on their research progress during the last 12 months.
