Dear Roszi:

I have your letter of May 17. I will look once more into the question of pictures and discuss it with you after your return from Europe.

I wonder whether you read in the newspapers about an interesting decision of the U.S. Supreme Court. Up to now a naturalized citizen lost his citizenship if he spent continuously more than three years in his country of origin (or more than five years in some other country. There were some exceptions depending on age, etc.) Depriving a naturalized citizen of his citizenship on this basis has now been declared unconstitutional by the U.S. Supreme Court. This could be of interest to you if you were ever to consider the possibility of retiring in Europe.
