

## **Chancellor and Mrs. Richard C. Atkinson host luncheon for four previous UCSD chancellors and wives**

Chancellor and Mrs. Richard C. Atkinson of the University of California, San Diego will host a luncheon for the four previous UC San Diego chancellors and their wives, the former director of Scripps Institution of Oceanography and his wife, and the UC Regent from San Diego and his wife at 11:30 a.m. Sunday, February 15, at the University House.

Dr. Atkinson, the former Director of the National Science Foundation in Washington, D.C., came to the UC San Diego campus as the fifth chancellor in July 1980. This will be the first time that all five chancellors will have been together at one social function.

Those attending the luncheon are:

Dr. and Mrs. Herbert F. York. Dr. York was appointed as the first chancellor of UC San Diego in 1961. He is currently a professor of physics and associated with the Program in Science, Technology and Public Affairs at UC San Diego.

Dr. and Mrs. John S. Galbraith. Dr. Galbraith was chancellor from 1964 until 1968. He is currently a professor of history at UCLA.

Dr. and Mrs. William J. McGill. Dr. McGill served as chancellor from 1968 until 1970 when he was named as the 16th president of Columbia University. He is currently retired in La Jolla and maintains an office in the Department of Psychology at UC San Diego.

Dr. and Mrs. William D. McElroy. Dr. McElroy was chancellor from 1971 until 1980. He is currently a professor of biology at UC San Diego.

Dr. and Mrs. Roger Revelle. Dr. Revelle served as director at Scripps for many years and was named, in 1958, to head the Institute of Technology and Engineering which was the forerunner of the UC San Diego general campus. He is currently associated with the Program in Science, Technology and Public Affairs at UC San Diego.

Mr. and Mrs. DeWitt A. Higgs. Mr. Higgs is a member of the University of California Board of Regents and is the only member from the San Diego area. He has served on the Board of Regents since 1966.
