

UCSD experimental theater group is previewing "The Amazing Amalgamated Amorphus"

The University of California, San Diego experimental theater group, The Anomaly Factory, will be previewing its production, "The Amazing Amalgamated Amorphous," at 8 p.m., Friday and Saturday, September 29-30.

"Amorphous" is a multi-sensation theatrical maze. Participants, who are urged to wear clothing suitable for crawling, are free to choose their own direction within the labyrinth, their length of stay and degree of participation. Portions of the production, which is housed in Bldg. 257 on the Matthews Campus, will be altered from week to week.

Regular performances will be held at 8 p.m., Friday and Saturday, from October 6 through November 11. Tickets for performances are \$2 for the general public and \$1 for students, and are available in the Student Activities Office, Urey Hall Lobby, on Revelle College, or at the Factory, Bldg. 257, Matthew.
