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CHANCELLOR'S 5K, ALUMNI EVENTS SLATED FOR OCT. 22-23 HOMECOMING

The fourth annual "Chancellor's Challenge 5K Run/Walk for Scholars at noon Oct. 22 will kick off an athletically-oriented Homecoming sponsored by Intercollegiate Athletics, the Alumni Association and Student Affairs.

Chancellor Robert Dynes again is challenging staff, faculty, students, alumni and friends in the community to join him in supporting undergraduate scholarships at UCSD. First, he's pledging to personally contribute \$25 for everyone who beats him to the finish line; secondly, he'll contribute \$40,000 and Charlie Robins, event chair, will contribute \$10,000, to jointly match sponsorships up to \$50,000.

And, for the first time this year, Frances Dynes Hellman will make a personal donation of \$25 for every woman who beats her.

Co-chair representatives are Tesh Khullar, students; Richard Zoehrer, staff, and Robert Parker, faculty, assisted by a planning committee headed by Linda Williams.

Last year's event netted just over \$100,000, and Dynes and Robins hope this year's event will top that amount. All proceeds go to support research scholarships and community scholarships for undergraduate students at UCSD.

Also scheduled Oct. 22 is a carillon concert at noon, Associated Students Fall Festival in the Price Center that evening, and a midnight alumni swimming and diving meet in Canyonview pool.

A noon Homecoming carnival which will feature entertainment, games, food and a beer garden will be held Oct. 23. Alumni athletic games in water polo, soccer and tennis will precede the noon event, followed by volleyball, basketball and soccer contests in the afternoon. A reception for alumni athletes will be held at 6:30 p.m.
