

## Wolfram, German folk singer, will present program at Sumner Auditorium January 19

Karl Wolfram, young German folk singer, will present a program of songs at Sumner Auditorium, University of California, San Diego, at 8:00 p.m. Friday, January 19, 1962.

The program includes German and Scandinavian songs, many dating to medieval times, and art songs of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries.

Wolfram, a baritone, accompanies himself on the lute and the theorbo. The theorbo, also known as the archlute, is a large, double-necked lute much used during the 17th century.

The event is sponsored by the Committee for Arts and Lectures of the San Diego campus. The public is invited. Admission is free.
