STATEMENT BY CHANCELLOR JOHN S. GALBRAITH UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, SAN DIEGO

I have long admired Clark Kerr as perhaps the most brilliant man of our day in American higher education.

The University is fortunate to have had such a leader.

As the Chancellor of the San Diego campus, I shall work with acting president Harry R. Wellman to advance the interests of UCSD and of the University as a whole.

This is a great University and UCSD has exceptional prospects. In concert with the faculty and with the regents, I shall devote myself to preventing these prospects from being blighted.
