

American Cancer Society announces grants to 3

Three UCSD scientists have been awarded funds for cancer-related research in grants just announced by the American Cancer Society.

Dr. Melvin H. Green, associate professor of biology, received \$11,533 for a year's research at the Imperial Cancer Fund Laboratories in London, England. Green will work on problems in mammalian viral systems, notably on the role of viruses in the formation of cancer.

Dr. Nathan O. Kaplan, professor of chemistry, was awarded \$7,326 to continue investigations into enzyme controls of cell growth, development and function.

A two-year postdoctoral fellowship of \$15,555 went to Dr. Michael Brenner. Brenner will work in the biology department with genetic systems using the slime mold amoeba as a model.
