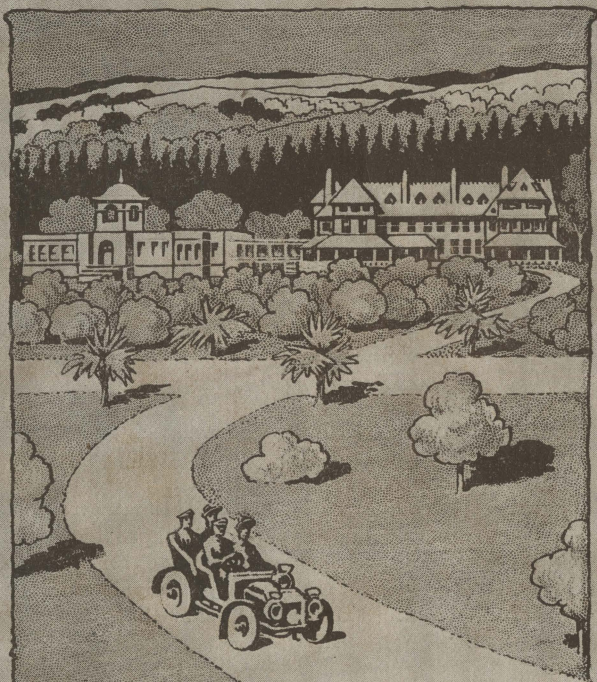

From San Diego it is most conveniently reached by boarding the motor cars of the Los Angeles & San Diego Beach Railway at the corner of Fourth and C Streets, or, by the trains of the same line at the foot of C Street.

Incoming guests on the Santa Fe trains need not come into the city proper, at all, but can leave the trains at Pacific Beach Station, where a conveyance will always meet them, provided the management has been notified either by letter or by wire of their expected arrival on a certain train. No charge is made for this service.

Well-cooked and daintily served meals appeal to even the most jaded appetites.

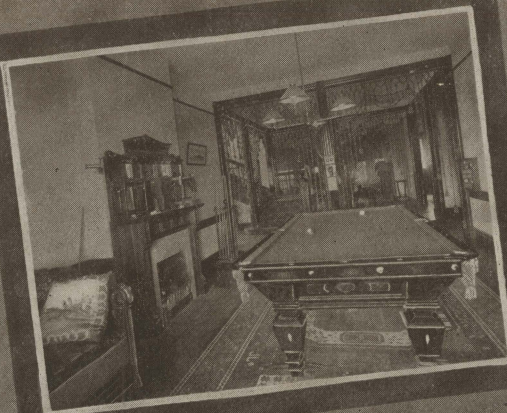
