NEW DIRECTOR OF UCSD TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING SERVICES NAMED

The appointment of Gregory Snee as director of Transportation and Parking Services at the University of California, San Diego, is announced by John A. Anderson, director of Community Safety.

Snee replaces Robert Umstead, who recently retired.

A veteran of nearly 13 years in the Transportation and Parking Services Department, Snee served five years of this at UCSD Medical Center as Parking and Transportation coordinator, and eight years as manager of the Transportation Alternatives program on the UCSD campus.

As manager of alternative transportation methods, including buses, vanpools, carpools and bicycles, Snee developed the largest such program in San Diego County. The service has received several awards, including recognition by the Governor's office for contributions to the community.

Snee received his undergraduate degree from UCSD. A resident of Temecula, he carpools (of course) to work every day.
