

Activities of Freshman Orientation Week and list of students

August 23, 1964

The pioneering freshman class of the San Diego campus of the University of California will get together for a barbecue on campus Sunday, September 13, to lead off an active Orientation Week.

The students and the faculty of UCSD will be the guests of the Honorary Alumni of UCSD at the barbecue, which will begin at 3:00 pm, Lieutenant Governor Glenn M. Anderson will head the list of distinguished visitors. Music will be provided by the Exotic Sounds of Arthur Lyman. The event is open to friends of the University, at a cost of \$10 per couple. Profits will go to the scholarship fund of the Honorary Alumni.

One hundred and eighty-five students are eligible to enroll as freshman. Of these, 64 are girls, 121 boys. All but 32 live in San Diego County.

Classes for the group open on Monday, September 21.

Monday of Orientation Week, September 14, will see the first assembly of the Class of 1968 at 9:00 a.m. They will hear addresses by Vice Chancellor John S. Galbraith, by Keith A. Brueckner, Dean of Letters and Science, The First College, and by Ted W. Forbes, Dean of Student Affairs. Later in the morning, the freshmen will take mathematics placement tests. They will be grouped in classes according to their skills in mathematics.

Monday afternoon, the Class of 1968 hear about registration procedures, the student health service, and an explanation of student life and organization plans for the academic year.

Following that, the commuters, who account for 61 per cent of the class, will meet to discuss their representation to the Associated Students of the University of California, San Diego, policies on student organizations, and self-government.

That evening the same topics will be discussed by the living groups. These are students who will live on campus or in nearby La Jolla motels. There are 72 of them, 36 girls, 36 boys. The girls will share apartments in UCSD's Married Student Apartments. The boys will have rooms in three La Jolla motels.

Actual registration begins Tuesday September 15, at 8:00 a.m. and will last through Wednesday, September 16.

Wednesday night the students will gather in UCSD's Sumner Auditorium to be entertained by a program of folk music by Sam D. Hinton. Mr. Hinton is a member of the staff of UCSD's Scripps Institution of Oceanography.

Thursday, September 17, will open with an assembly at which Certificates of Honors at Entrance will be presented by Vice Chancellor Galbraith. These Certificates are given students whose grades in certain required subjects in high school have approached a straight "A" average (one "B" is allowed). The freshmen will then hear an explanation of UCSD's unusual language program and a discussion of the University library. They will then tour the Library, the Language Center, and the campus. In the afternoon an off-campus garden party is planned at the University Lutheran Church. That evening, they will split into small groups for informal visits to faculty homes.

The final day of Orientation Week, Friday, September 18, will open with a lecture and discussion of C.S. Lewis's famous satire, "The Screwtape Letters." UCSD staff members will talk about the issues raised by the book and during the second hour, lead small group discussions.

The week will end with a beach party on the University beach starting at 1:00 p.m.
