

Dr. Daniel Orr is PILS lecturer

Dr. Daniel Orr, professor of economics at the University of California, San Diego, will deliver the eighth lecture in the Professors' Inaugural Lecture Series at 4:15 p.m. on Thursday, March 6, in the Humanities-Library Auditorium, Revelle College, UCSD.

Dr. Orr's topic will be "A Simple Empirical Evaluation of Neo-Marxist Dogma."

Dr. Orr has taught at UCSD for three years. He received his B.A. degree at Oberlin College in Ohio and his Ph.D. in economics at Princeton. Before joining UCSD, he taught at Amherst College in Massachusetts and at the University of Chicago.

The lecture, presented by the UCSD Committee for Arts and Lectures, will be free and open to the public.
