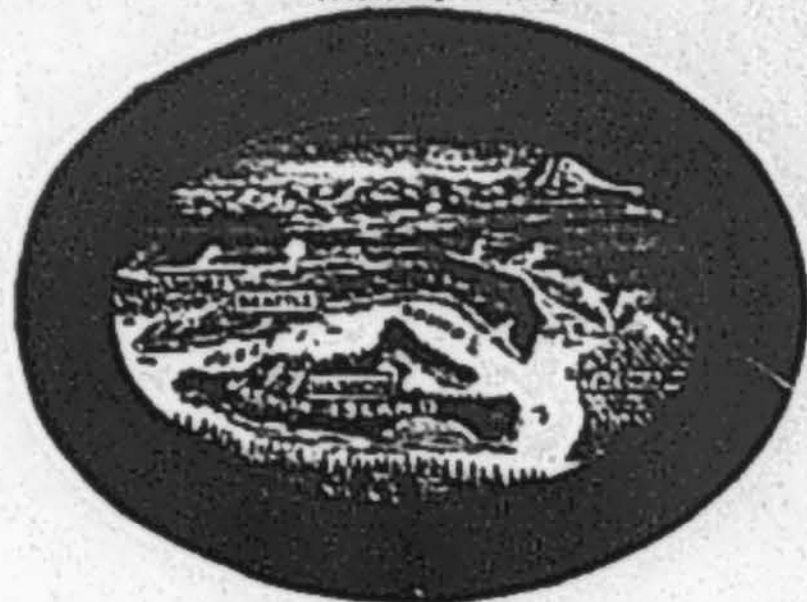

The neighbors stated that there ~~are~~ is little or no water in the reserv- oir, and they do not seem to know whether the water will be on hand for farming use, Please let me know whether I will get water, and if so when, and whether water will be on hand to protect the trees and grow the crops all summer- It will be a lot better to know before planting than afterward, and I will depend on you to tell me exactly what you will do now and all summer, promptly and oblige

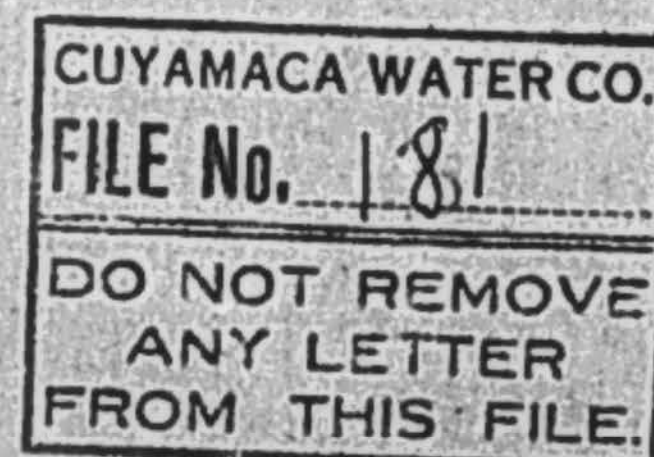
We have your letter of April 3rd re-
