To whom it may concern:

By authority of the Tenth section of an act of Congress entitled an act to provide internal revenue to support the Government, to pay interest on the public debt and for other purposes," approved June 30th 1864, I, W. N. Slocum, Collector of Internal Revenue for the Second Collection District of California, do hereby appoint E. W. Morse, of San Diego, Deputy Collector of Internal Revenue in and for the county of San Diego, with full power to receive and receipt for Revenue taxes, sell Revenue Stamps, and perform all other duties belonging to the office of Deputy Collector, as provided in the act aforesaid and by subsequent acts of Congress, and the Regulations of the Secretary of the Treasury and the Commissioners of Internal Revenue.
