

Construction projects currently underway at UCSD

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Recreation/Intermural and Athletic Center (RIMAC): Cost, \$33.5 million. Construction started in January, 1993, completion due in October, 1994. Provides 186,640 gross square feet of indoor recreation facilities for students, faculty and staff for intercollegiate, intramural and open recreation purposes.

Social Sciences Building: Cost, \$15.3 million. Construction started in March, 1994; completion due in July, 1995. Four story, 45,148 assignable square feet for seminar, conference and labs for academic departments within the Social Sciences division.

Classroom Building I: Cost, \$12.6. Construction started January, 1994, due to be completed in September of 1995. The three-story building will include a 300-seat auditorium, two 200-seat rooms, six classrooms seating 150 and 14 rooms seating 80 or fewer, all for general assignment use.

Molecular Biology Research Facility Unit III: Cost, \$30 million. Construction started in March, 1993; completion due in December, 1995. Primarily research labs for use by School of Medicine.

Material Handling Facility: Cost, \$4.5 million. Started May, 1994; completion due in December, 1995. Replaces Old Miramar Road facility; now adjacent to Physical Plant Services. Processes lab materials.

Ratner Children's Eye Center: Cost, \$848,000. Groundbreaking held in June, 1994, completion scheduled in March, 1995. Located adjacent to Shiley Eye Center at UCSD Medical Center-La Jolla site.

Early Childhood Education Facility expansion. Cost, \$700,000. Adds classroom space to this pre-school facility. Completion in November, 1995.

Library Walk: Cost, \$1.8 million. This major mall will change the appearance of the central campus. Extends from Molecular Biology Research Facility Unit III to the University Library, will necessitate new entrances to buildings. Now under design; due for completion in September, 1995.

Science and Engineering Research Facility. Cost, \$19 million. Will contain 61,000 assignable square feet for School of Engineering labs. Going out to bid this fall; due for completion in spring of 1996.

Supercomputer Addition: Cost, \$2 million. Now in working drawings, due for completion in March, 1996.

Thermal Energy Storage System: Cost, \$3.4 million. Large tank to replace present structure at Gilman and Osler avenues. Underway now, due for completion in June, 1995.

University Center Building 303: Cost, \$1. Renovation and addition for labs and offices for this School of Medicine building. Due to be completed in January, 1996.

Parking Lots: Four new parking lots will be built, beginning in December, 1994. The lots, two on the central campus and two on the eastern edge, will provide approximately 330 additional spaces.

Great Whale Exhibit: \$500,000 donation. The exhibit at the entrance to the Aquarium will include a fountain and pools and 40 foot whale. Due in the spring of 1995.

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
