

Fourth annual Friends of the UCSD Library book sale

April 16, 1976

The fourth annual Friends of the UCSD Library book sale will be held Saturday and Sunday, May 1-2, on the entrance walk of the Central University Library at the University of California, San Diego.

Over 7,000 books will be on sale during the two days from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Included will be many unusual scholarly publications on a wide range of subjects, books in foreign languages and fiction and non-fiction best sellers.

Prices range from 25 cents to a few dollars with most items selling for less than a dollar.

The majority of the items to be sold were collected by the Friends of the UCSD Library for the event. Proceeds from the sale will be used by the Friends to purchase special books and materials needed for various library collections.

The Friends is made up of 1,000 community members, UC San Diego faculty and staff and others who support the university's library through the building of special collections and by raising funds to support its growth. Over the years, the Friends have been instrumental in helping build such special collections as those dealing with Baja California, the desert and oceanography. Mrs. Laurence McGilvery of La Jolla is chairperson of this year's book sale.
