Background: A professor of psychology, Ebbesen's research centers on psychology and the law. His work includes such issues as the reliability of eye witness reports, the influence of pretrial bias on the fairness of jurors, and what factors participants in the legal system take into account when deciding such things as sentencing, bail setting, and whether to prosecute.
