

3rd Annual College & University Info Fair

Recruiters representing nearly 45 universities and colleges from throughout California are scheduled to take part in the third annual College and University Information Fair Wednesday, October 24, 1984, at the University of California, San Diego.

The fair, the only one of its kind to be held in the San Diego area, is open to all prospective college students interested in public and private California colleges and universities. The academic recruiters will be on hand to answer questions and to provide information about special educational opportunities, financial aid, and academic programs at the various universities and colleges.

The fair is scheduled from 7 to 9 p.m. in the Recreation Gym at UCSD which is located directly south of the Main Gym in the center of the campus.

According to Shirley Balbin, outreach officer and coordinator at UCSD, the fair is traditionally one of the largest college fairs held in this area and will be well worth the time for anyone thinking of entering college within the next year.

"Comprehensive, up-to-date information available to participants can help them make better choices of schools and programs in which to apply," Balbin said.
