

Revelle and Muir Chamber Choruses join in concert

UCSD students in the Revelle College and John Muir College Chamber Choruses will present a Choral Concert on Thursday, May 28, beginning at 8:30 p.m. in the Matthews Campus Recital Hall. The program is free and the public is invited.

Nancy Roblin, graduate student in the Department of Music, will direct the combined choral ensembles in a program of works by Baroque, Renaissance and contemporary composers.

Works by Robert Baksa, Ralph Vaughan-Williams, San Diego composer Louise Spizizen, Krzysztof Penderecki and Robert Ashley will form the contemporary group. The ensemble will also sing compositions by Schutz and William Porter, and a group of madrigals by Janequin, Le Jeune, Dowland, Lassus and Scandello.

Soloists Jeri Dodge and Joanne Gates will sing A Dialogue of Two Shepherds by William Byrd, assisted by instrumentalists Daniel Goode, recorder, Nikhil Dave, viola, Michael Redd, bassoon, and Elinor Barron, 'cello. The concert will close with a performance of Gibbon's Street Cries of London.
