

Exhibit of paintings by Bob Wade displayed at UCSD Art Gallery

Paintings by Texas artist Bob Wade will be displayed at the University of California, San Diego through Dec. 9 in an exhibit at the UCSD Art Gallery.

Wade is best known for his work depicting the violence of the Texas landscape. Assisted by a grant from the National Endowment for the Arts, he is pursuing his interest in documenting regional emotions and feelings in art.

Wade has exhibited in many galleries throughout the country and his work has been included in the annual of the Whitney Museum of American Art.
