

Pearl Lang Dance Troupe to perform March 11

One of America's foremost dancer-choreographers, Pearl Lang, will bring her company of nine talented young dancers to Sherwood Hall, La Jolla, Thursday, March 11, as part of the University of California All-University Concert Series.

The program will begin at 8:30 P.M. Unreserved seating is 50 cents to University of California, San Diego, students and \$1.50 for the general public.

Co-sponsored by the University's Intercampus Cultural Exchange Committee and the UCSD Committee for Arts and Lectures, the varied program will include the premiere of Gunther Schuller's "Dismembered Fable." This work was commissioned for the All-University series.

Miss Lang shared professional and advanced classes with Martha Graham at her famous studio and School of Contemporary Dance. Since 1949 Miss Lang has achieved outstanding recognition as a choreographer and star of her own company. She has been recognized as a dancer of exquisite beauty and dazzling technical command.
