UCSD OFFERS FREE TOURS OF CAMPUS FOR RESIDENTS AND VISITORS

San Diego residents and visitors may enjoy a 90-minute mini-van or walking tour of the University of California, San Diego, campus, including a portion of the world-renowned Stuart Outdoor Sculpture Collection.

The Sunday afternoon tours, besides providing an overview of the campus, include short stops at Thornton Hospital, Stephen Birch Aquarium and the Scripps Institution of Oceanography.

Mini-van tours are available the first and third Sundays of each month, starting at 2 p.m. from the Gilman Information Pavilion. Wheelchair accessibility is available upon request. Walking tours are offered on alternate Sundays, also starting at 2 p.m., from the Gilman Pavilion. Group tours can be arranged.

The tours are conducted through the UCSD Visitors Program. There is a minimal UCSD parking fee for those participating. Reservations are necessary. Call 534-4414.
