

## Library of Laurence M. Huey acquired by the University of California, San Diego

The 2000-volume library of Laurence M. Huey, curator of birds and mammals at the San Diego Society of Natural History since 1923, has been acquired by the University of California, San Diego, Melvin J. Voigt, Librarian, announced this week.

The collection, almost all in the fields of ornithology and mammalogy, contains many important sets, such as Bannerman and Lodge, The Birds of the British Isles, Nicoll's Birds of Egypt, and nearly complete collections of the writing of such well-known ornithologists as Dawson, Ridgeway, Chapin, Coues, Grinnell, and Bent. It also includes complete files of all of the important periodicals and serials in these subject fields.

The collection will be added to the Library of the Scripps Institution of Oceanography.
