UCSD'S ALUMNI AWARENESS WEEK, APRIL 6-12, FEATURES COMMUNITY OUTREACH LECTURE ON THE ENVIRONMENT BY UCSD SCIENTISTS

"The Environment and You," a community outreach program dealing with important ecological issues, will be one of several events featured during the University of California, San Diego's first Alumni Awareness Week, April 6-12.

UCSD biologist Paul Saltman, and UCSD Scripps Institution of Oceanography scientists Wolfgang Berger (SIO alumnus) and Scott Jenkins (SIO alumnus), will be the major speakers for the event to be held from 6:30 -9 p.m. April 8, at the UCSD Price Center Theatre, beginning with a public reception.

Saltman's topic will be science literacy in education; Berger will discuss global warming and the El Nino effect, and Jenkins, who is director of the SurfRider Foundation, will talk about our coastal environment and its management. The talks will be followed by question and answer sessions.

The moderator for the program will be Carolyn Chase ('78), who is director of San Diego Earth Day, a non-profit organization. Karen Winston ('80), coordinator of the event and a member of the UCSD Alumni Association board of directors, will open the program.

General admission is \$5 and students tickets are \$3.

Tickets may be purchased through the UCSD Alumni Relations Office at 534-3900, through April 6. Parking permits are required on the UCSD campus and may be purchased for \$2 at the information pavilions on Northyiew Drive and Gilman Drive.
