The irrigation meters to be read and taken care of by us, also the collections for said irrigation waters; and the balance of the water charged to you at 11.2 cents per 100 cubic feet.

We will, under this arrangement, endeavor to have such action approved by the railroad commission until a rehearing. If they disapprove of such action, we will abide by their interpretation.

We refer to Rule 6, 7 and 8.

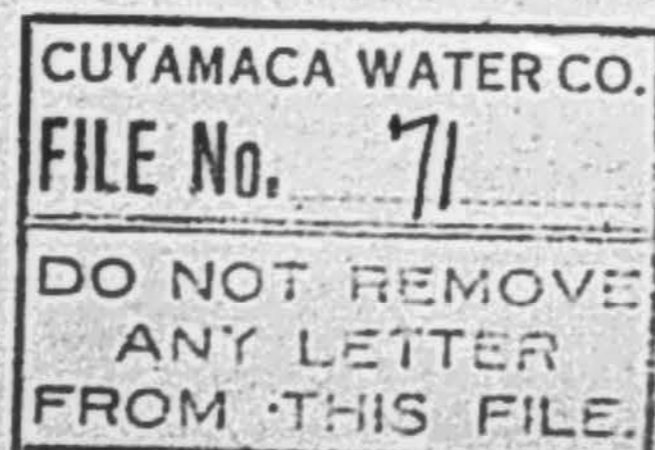

Attention Mr H C Park

Inclosed herewith please find statement of accounts of water consumers of the Chollas Mutual Water Co. showing a credit of \$17.30 and check for this amount in your favor. This settlement is on the basis of 75¢ per month for domestic water. Any correction necessary will be made to suit the decision of the Railroad Commission regarding the rate to be charged prior to July 1, 1914. Commencing Sept. 1st, therefore, we will charge the rate of \$5.85 per Miners Inch for irrigation water and 15¢ a thousand gallons for domestic water. If it is satisfactory to you, we will continue to read the irrigation meters in order that we can prorate the domestic and irrigation use. You have been notified that the ^{irrigation} supply since Sept. 10th has been cut down to one-half.

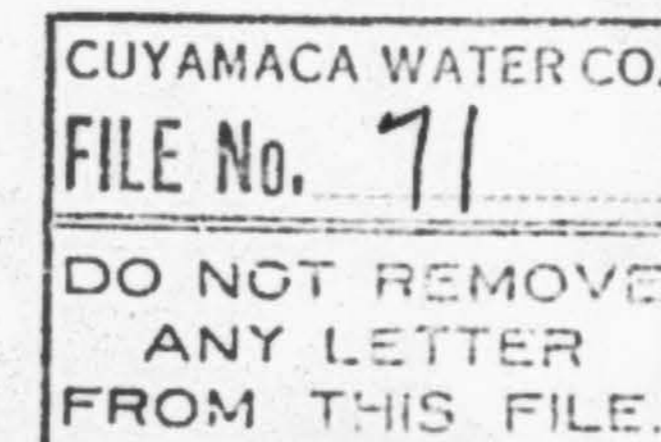

We have your bill of October 1st, in which you charge for water at 15¢ per thousand gallons to the amount of 43.95. You failed to give us any meter readings for August 30th, and it is therefore impossible for us to divide this amount. It was our understanding that in the absence of these readings you would charge the minimum rate. We would therefore ask you to charge the bill accordingly, or give us the meter readings in order that we may divide the amounts up.

Mr. George B. Wilken claims to have paid you one dollar for his water for August. Such being the case you should credit us with another dollar on that account.

Gentlemen:

We have your letter of October 8th in reply to ours of October 6th. You have given us the readings for the irrigating consumers, but it was the readings of the domestic consumers that were in question. As we said in our letter before, if you are unable to supply the readings for the domestic consumers I presume your bill will have to be corrected, making the charge for the domestic water on the basis of the minimum.

With reference to the Wilken bill for August, refer to your letter and statement of September 16th, showing a credit in our favor of \$17.30. On this statement you have charged Allen White \$1.45 and George B. Wilken \$1.00. This amount having been paid to you the Chollas Mutual Water Co. is now entitled to a credit of \$18.30, I presume.
