

British composer Cardew plays here

The "Power Throne," a mixed electronic media environment built around the human heart beat, is being exhibited in the University of California, San Diego Art Gallery through Sunday, May 24.

According to Art News, the artist, Robert Newman, who designed the environment, "creates a new kind of poetry in his red, crimson, pink, reverberatory chamber" and "has a way of calling attention to the basic, inattentive and unknown parts of yourself that leads you carefully into your own core, controlling message and mystery and warm aura of mediators."

The UCSD Art Gallery, located on the Matthews Campus east of Gilman Drive, is open free to the public. Gallery hours are 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Tuesday through Sunday, and 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 P.M., Wednesday evenings.
