Dear Sir - Concerning what you asked about the Maguader tract. There are five acres - nine houses - one tent, occupying less than  $\frac{1}{2}$  half the area, the remainder is vacant and not using water. All use spring water for domestic use (drinking and cooking). The supply pipe for flume water runs diagonally across that area adjoining tract's area and is about a doz years old.

I submitted your proposition to the people on this tract. They do not approve of it. There are four owning more than  $\frac{1}{2}$  an acre each. My patch  $\frac{2}{3}$  of an acre. I usually paid  $\frac{1}{2}$  yearly. I do not care about that: The original owner paid \$800. for the privilege of buying water at \$35. an inch. either legally or illegally the rate is arbitrarily raised to \$70. I suppose I am to pay  $\frac{2}{3}$  of  $\frac{1}{5}$  of the price of  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch water. I got receipt to July 1st. Since then I got two bills for June and one for July all incorrect I think.

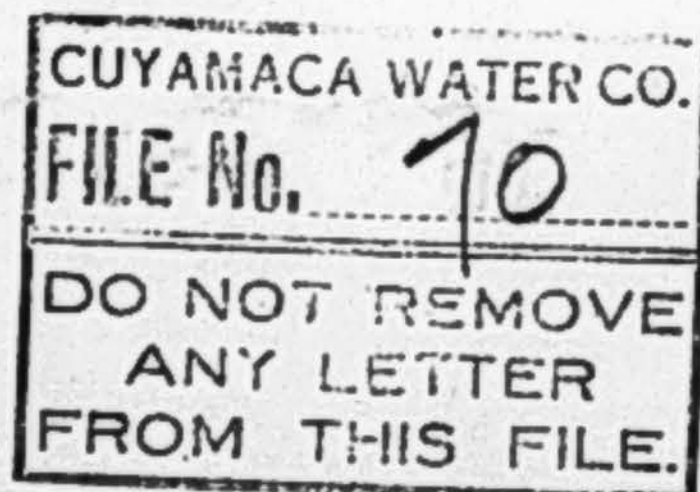

note when I came home yesterday. (had  
been at Imperial beach a couple of  
weeks.) I called at your office but got no  
satisfaction concerning pipe to Magnesian  
Tract (and meter). If each man had a  
meter he could put a check on one  
man's wasting more water in a water  
 famine than all the customers on the  
Tract need.

The increase in rates for water is of less intent  
to me than the pipe and meter which  
the Commission ruled must be put in if  
the rate was raised.

I find by referring to my dues that the Magnesian  
Tract water right was  $\frac{2}{3}$  of an inch I paid the  
bank for July -
