A few blocks beyond the business portion of the city, as the ground rises from the bay and rolls off over the mesa, is Albatross Terrace, a garden of homes in an Eden of environment. There are dwelling-houses, apartments, suites, and single rooms, all convenient and attractive, and at reasonable rents. The interior grounds are laid out in lawns, with trees, flowers, and choice plants, under the care of competent gardeners. Summer houses of bamboo covered with flowering vines, which admit the cool fresh air while excluding the sun and sometimes too severe breeze from the ocean, are placed at intervals throughout the grounds, affording delightful retreats and places of rendezvous for the occupants of the Terrace. Winding down through the grounds, from the various residences, and the garden-houses, are cement walks leading to the dining and reading rooms of the Inn.

Albatross Inn is a family hotel of the first class, open all the year, with furniture and appointments entirely new. The table

is always excellent, and service prompt. Terms, \$2.50 a day; \$10 to \$14 a week. It is a pleasant feature that, besides the single rooms and suites, the Inn can offer its guests separate houses and apartments if desired, with home comforts and exclusiveness. The Inn has also fruit from its own farm, milk from its own dairy, and the purest and best of water. Thus every facility is offered for those living at the Terrace to keep house or board as they may prefer.

Albatross Terrace, San Diego, is a summer and winter health and pleasure resort, in a climate which has not its equal in the world. In full view are the bay and ocean, whence comes every day throughout the year a cool refreshing breeze. The average temperature is 65 deg. with less than ten degrees variation summer or winter, night or day. Unlike the seashore on the eastern side of the continent, the California seaboard is everywhere ten or fifteen degrees cooler in summer and warmer in winter than the valleys of the interior. It is a dry marine air, pure and invigorating, no frost, no enervating heat, no malaria, sunstrokes, lightning, hurricanes, or tornadoes. There are here no native diseases. Sun and sea unite their healing forces. All influences make for life and health; there is nothing

present to engender disease. Change from high altitudes, or hot, moist, enervating atmospheres, or cold, damp, stormy sections to this warm, dry, invigorating air and temperate healthful sunshine, must always be productive of most beneficial results. Hundreds of cases can be cited of complete restoration to health from nervous, rheumatic, and bronchial troubles, as the result of a residence of a few months in San Diego.

Among the many attractions of the place are boating, fishing, bathing, and excursions by land and water to notable places. Good shooting is found in season in the hills and mountains adjacent.

As regards population and progress, commerce and manufactures, San Diego is now the fourth city in California; it is destined, in due time, to be second only to San Francisco. The developments in the Pacific, following the war with Spain; the Nicaragua canal, and an air-line railway to the east, will change the industrialism of the California coast, giving to its few good harbors their due prominence and value.
