Presenting "Queen of Flowers and Pearls" performance

"Queen of flowers and pearls" is a long voyage to time and its spaces that examines the life and the vicissitudes of an Italian family during the Italian occupation of Libya: the period of Mengesha Habte Mariam's dictatorship and during the subsequent decade when they are engaged.

Out of the novel come the idea of creating a narrative performance which incorporates a plurality of voices. On the one hand, there is a narration of the violent passage of Italian colonialism in the life of the author's maternal family; on the other, different "I" come from the novel are searched for the audience through other readings. Both narrative and readings are combined with traditional Ethiopian songs sung by the author herself.

Cheremelli has emphasized how identifying creates an intimacy between strangers and allows the audience and the author to vicariously share the same emotions.

Italy-Libyan, Gabriella Cheremelli was born in Adria, Abulia in 1965 and she moved to Italy in 1979, where she lives in Bologna, her father's town. Following the use of free novel like typical of Ethiopian cultural tradition, she writes and acts in narrative plays that she presents all over the world. In 2017, her debut novel *Queen of Pearls and Flowers* based on the stories of Ethiopian patriots fighting against Italian occupation and winner of several awards, was published by Ubaldini. In 2018, the English translation, *Queen of Flowers and Pearls*, was published by Indiana University Press, and in 2019, the novel was translated into Arabic with the title *Il Re Etniopi*. A&A.



In 2010, in an effort to foster artistic creation and mutual dialogue between Italian and Ethiopian musicians, Cheremelli created the Arts Endowed Project (<http://www.artsendowed.org/naacp/18-projects/>).




