Manuelita Brown serves as the director of UC San Diego's Honor Achievement Workshops and is an active member of UCSD Alumni's Black Alumni Council and the UCSD Alumni Board of Directors. Since 2003, she has chaired the Black Alumni Scholarship Fund Committee and served as liaison between the UC San Diego Foundation, its scholarship office and the San Diego Foundation. A renowned sculptor, Brown's latest work, a bronze statue of Sojourner Truth, recognizes Truth's deep humanity, commitment to education and pursuit of equal rights. In 2013, Brown's work was recognized with a "Village Award," an award presented annually to persons who have made a difference in the African American Community by returning their talents to the community. With a background in math and psychology and as a local and public artist, UCSD alum, and educator, Brown truly exemplifies Sixth's values: she and her work are innovative, interconnected, and aware.

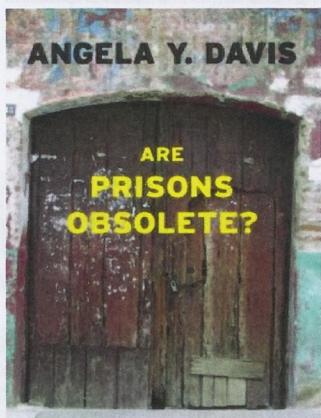

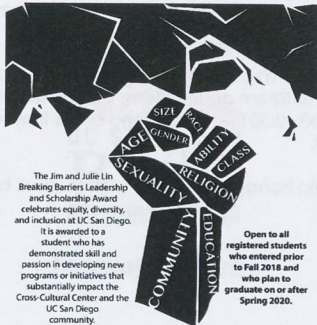
CGS 87: Are Prisons Obsolete?
