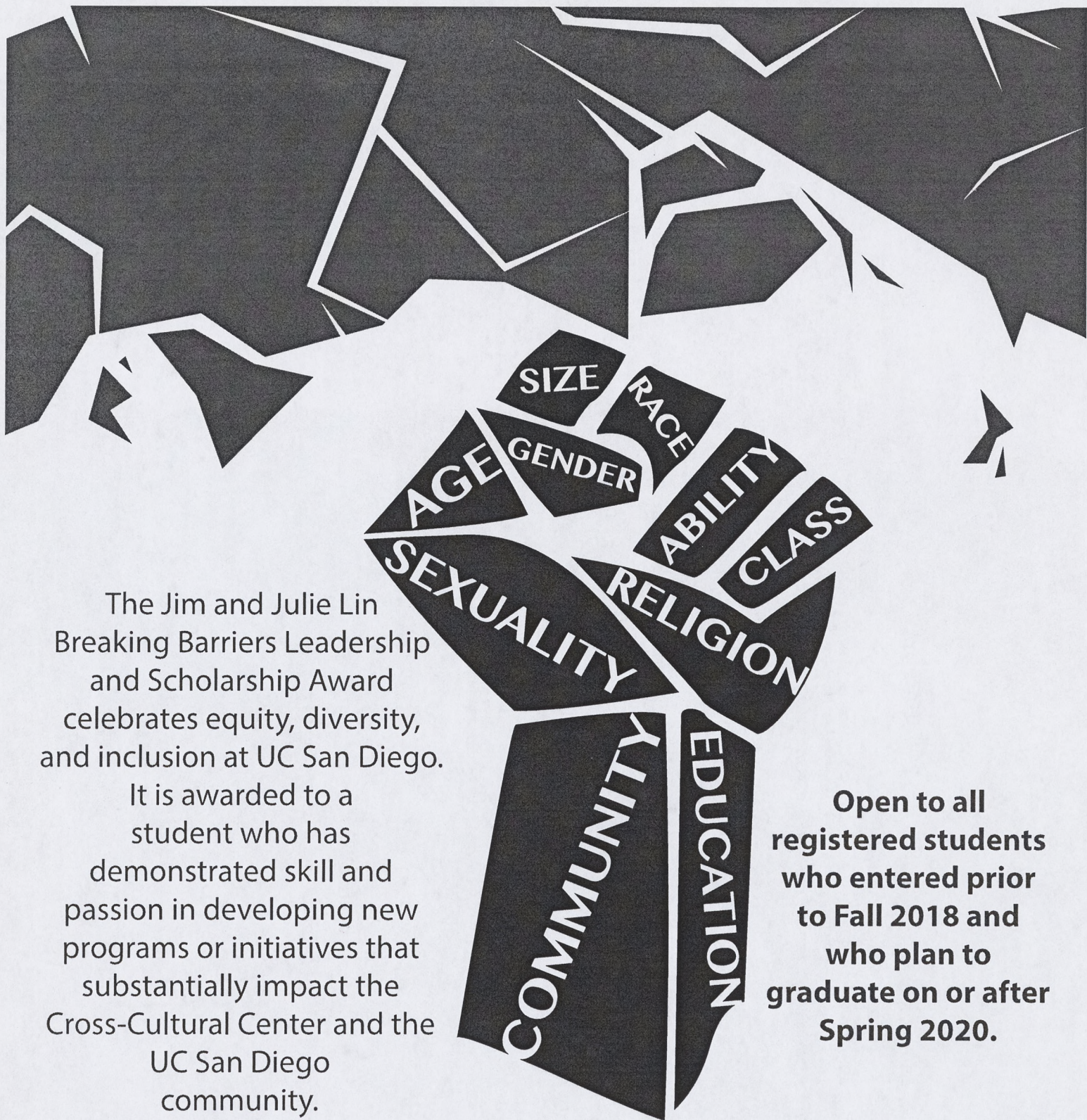
# OUT AND PROUD SERIES



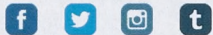

## Special Announcements: Preferred Names and Personal Pronouns for UC San Diego Students

Dear friends of the UC San Diego LGBT Resource Center~

If you have not yet seen the **campus announcement** regarding preferred names and personal pronouns for students, please see the information below.

Beginning this spring, all students are able to provide the University with preferred first and middle names, as well as personal pronouns, in the campus data systems. This process is available through the Social Identities link on a student's **MyTritonLink**. The University will use a student's preferred name, except in very limited circumstances where a legal name is required.

This is an incredible moment for UC San Diego, and one that has been discussed since I began here in 2001, when our first trans group, called Queering Gender, organized and met with the then-Registrar to ask for space to name themselves in campus records. Over the last 18 years, we have made slow, steady progress in changing people's beliefs and holding space for our community to name ourselves and have the

pronouns used which give us the honor and respect for our true identities. Today marks a powerful milestone in our recognition!

Thank you for your committed support of our work, the UC San Diego LGBT Resource Center, and our community. There is more work to be done, but now is the time to spread the word, to help folks access the new systems and provide their names and pronouns, and to celebrate our ability to live fully at our institution with respect and dignity for our names and pronouns.

### Anti-Colonialism Day April 22 | 6:00 - 9:00 PM | Price Center Theater

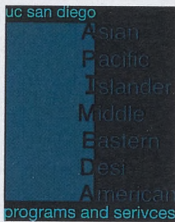
