The VOICES Leadership Program is designed to build a community of women leaders committed to social change.

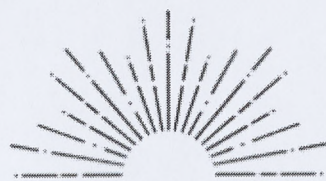
The program consists of attendance at a day-long leadership retreat followed by participation in a series of Women's Center programs throughout the year.

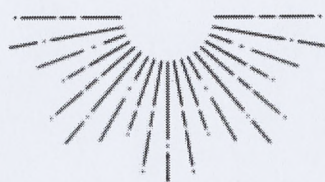

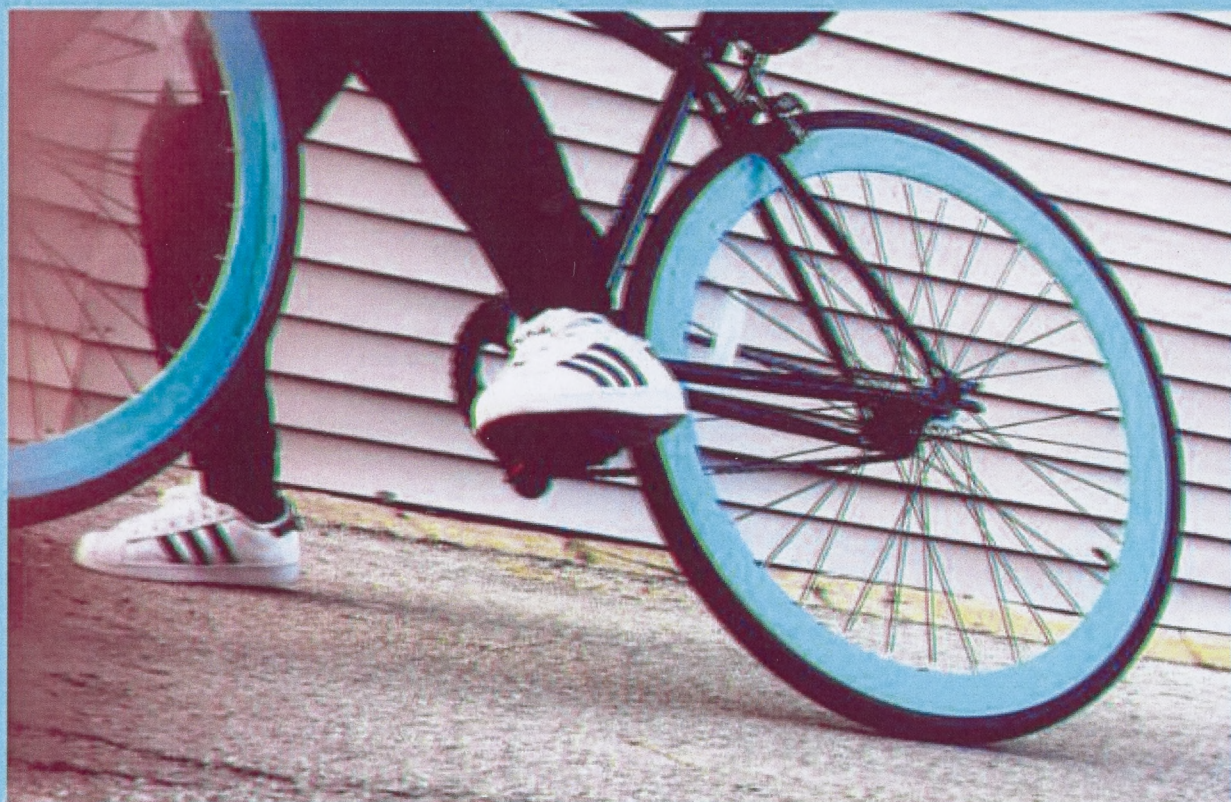
