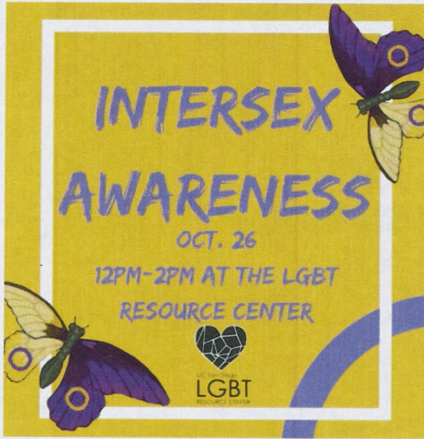

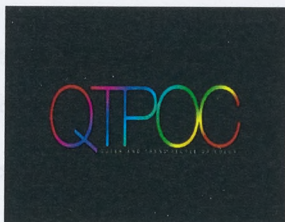

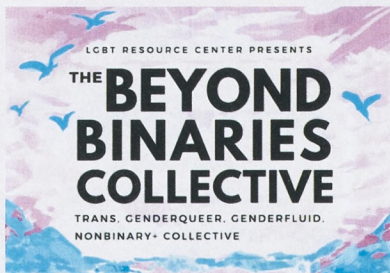

### Yearning Toward Carrie Buck with Eli Clare

Eli Clare, a prominent trans scholar and activist, working at the intersections of disability, queer, and gender studies,





will be giving a lecture entitled "Yearning Toward Carrie Buck" which looks at the infamous Supreme Court case *Buck v. Bell*. The case, declared involuntary sterilization laws constitutional in 1927, was built upon the body of Carrie Buck, a poor white woman from Virginia. Using history, poetry, images, and imagination, Eli Clare explores how disability, class, gender, and whiteness often collide and asks questions about the relationship between bodies on one hand and law, history, and metaphor on the other.

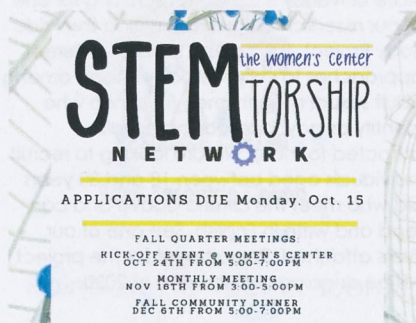

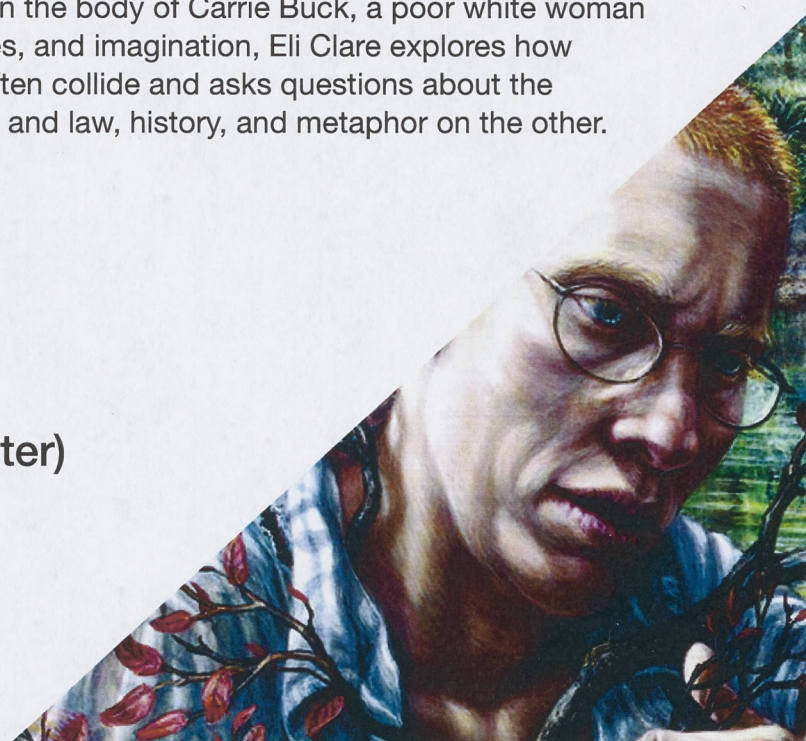

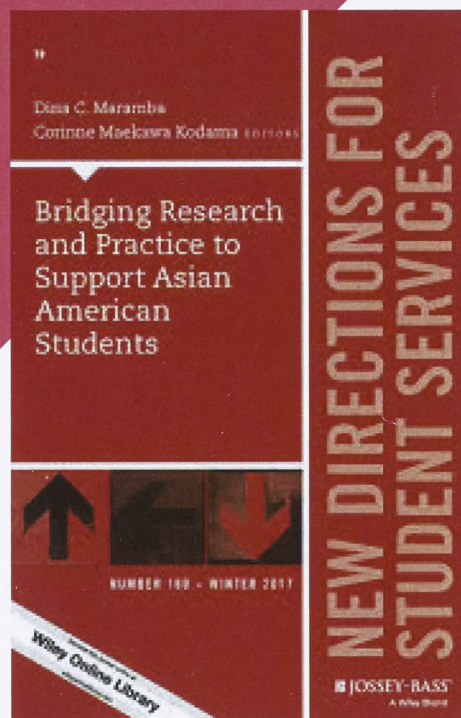
Love Your Body Day is an annual campaign that challenges the message that a person's value is measured through their ability to embody current unrealistic beauty standards perpetuated by the media.
