


The November 6, 2018 General Election is approaching and UC San Diego encourages eligible students, faculty, and staff to exercise their voting rights.



He came out as gay to his wife, Liu Sanlian, and left his family to be with Jay, his partner. Only months afterwards, Zhenayuan passed away. Sanlian's anger reaches a breaking point when she discovers Jay is the sole beneficiary on her husband's life insurance policy and to get the money, she has to strike up a relationship with the man he was in love with. To complicate matters, her teenage son Chenaxi, frustrated with the adults in his life, runs away from home and moves in with Jay, uninvited and unwanted, to learn more about the mysterious relationship his father had with this other man
