

Seaborg will speak on "New Paths in Education" on March 25 in celebration of the University of California's 94th Charter Anniversary

Glenn T. Seaborg, Chairman of the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission and Nobel Laureate, will speak on "New Paths in Education" as the San Diego campus of the University of California celebrates the 94th Charter Anniversary of the University on Sunday, March 25.

The event will be held at Sherwood Hall, Art Center in La Jolla, at 8:00 p.m. Most of the auditorium will be open to the public. Doors open at 7:30 P.M.

Also appearing in the ceremony will be Vice President Harry Wellman, Berkeley, who will deliver the Annual Message, and Chancellor Herbert York, who will review the year's developments at San Diego.

Representing San Diego State College at the ceremony will be Vice President Ernest B. O'Byrne, San Diego State College; Dr. Russell A. Beam, Dean of the School of Business; and Dr. Stephen J. Barres, Academic Dean, College for Men of the University of San Diego.

Also present at the ceremony will be Lieutenant Governor Glenn Anderson, one of the Regents of the University, and Mr. James W. Archer, La Jolla, who as President of the California Alumni Association has served for the past year as a Regent. Rev. Dr. Robert W. McClellan, pastor of the La Jolla Presbyterian Church, will pronounce the Invocation and Benediction.

Mr. Kimo R. Morgan, Vice President-Business, and Mr. Raymond W. Kettler, President-Finance, both of Berkeley, will also participate.

The ceremony will begin with the traditional academic procession, led by Dr. Denis L. Fox, Professor of Marine Biochemistry and Marshal for the San Diego campus.

Dr. and Mrs. Seaborg will arrive in La Jolla late Sunday afternoon. They will be dinner guests of Chancellor and Mrs. York. They will stay at La Valencia Hotel. Dr. Seaborg will leave Monday for Riverside, where he will deliver the Charter Day address at the Riverside campus that night.
