
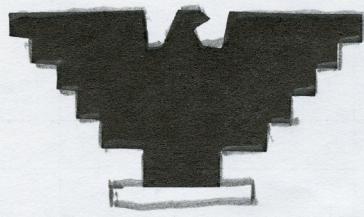


No place for racism!
